RESOLUTION NO. 89- 4

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is entrusted with the immediate and long term care and development of its tribal membership and the community at large; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council intends to provide tribal members and the community at large with every opportunity for growth, resources, and development available to tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council places the highest priority on the children who are recognized as the most valuable resource for community growth and development; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council provides full support to make application for the Indian Child Welfare Funds, P.L. 95-608, to provide important services to our children, for a three year duration.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve submission of the Indian Child Welfare Application for three years to provide services to the Indian Families within our Community; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman, Vice-Chairman, or Tribal Business Manager to act as the Official Tribal Representative for this grant application with full authority to negotiate, amend and execute all grant documents for the duration of this contract period.
