RESOLUTION NO. 89-8
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing for the needs of the community including, but not limited to, health, education and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has determined that the Senior Citizens of the Tribe are not adequately served by State or areawide programs for the aging; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council desires to provide the maximum amount of services possible to assist the tribal seniors with a variety of social, economic, and health problems; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council believes that the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency is the most appropriate organization to administer and A.O.A. Title VI Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency is hereby authorized to apply for and administer an Administration on Aging Title VI Program on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe and its Senior Citizens; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the the Squaxin Island Tribal Council will co-operate fully with the Title IV Program.
