


## **SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE**



WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has determined that the membership and people in the Squaxin Community require programs and services which meet their cultural, health, educational, informational, and recreational needs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Alcohol Director has been involved with DWI Assessment working closely with the law enforcement agencies in the local and peninula region for Indian clients; and

WHEREAS, the expanded work required for the DWI Assessment of Indian clients needs to be prioritized to meet the law enforcement and court requirements to resolve cases and work out a treatment plan for Indian clients; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Alcoholism Staff to submit a grant applicatio to Washington DSHS for RFP Announcement from Thurston/Mason Alcoholism and other Drug Advisory Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this program will provide the necessary staff to perform DWI assessment work to satisfy the law enforcement and courts for Indian clients in local service area and Peninsula are Indian residents and provide assistance to Indian Alcohol Staff when requested to do this work; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman, Vice-Chairman, or Tribal Administrative Director to act as the Official Tribal Representative for this grant application with full authority to negotiate, amend and execute all grant documents.
