



# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

## RESOLUTION NO. 89-59 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health and economic well-being of the Squaxin Island Tribe and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is responsible for managing its tribal fishery; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the Northwest Indian Fisheries Commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby appoint Jim Peters, Fisheries Manager as the official representative of Squaxin Island Tribe to the Northwest Indian Fisheries Commission.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby appoint David Lopeman, Tribal Chairman as alternate voting representative to serve in Jim's absence.
