RESOLUTION NO. 90-06 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has been a member in good standing of the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) since its inception in 1976, and


WHEREAS, SPIPA in FY 89 submitted and received funding on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe for a three year project under the Older Americans Act Title VI Part A, Grants to Indian Tribes for Supportive and Nutritional Services to Older Americans, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is advised that the FY 90/FY 91 AOA Title VI proposal is due not later than March 1, 1990.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer, on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe, an FY 90/FY 91 proposal and program under the Older Americans Act, Title VI Part A, Grants to Indian Tribes for supportive and Nutritional Services to Older Americans.


C E R T I F I C A T I O N
