RESOLUTION NO. 90-18 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and


WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to obtain satisfactory water supply and adequate waste disposal facilities for Indians of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Indian health Service desires to assist in the installation of water supply and sewage disposal facilities for Indians on the Squaxin Island Reservaiton.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve entering into the MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE AND THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE. PUBLIC LAW 86-121, PROJECT PO-89-537D and the Project Summary attached thereto.
