RESOLUTION NO. 90-24
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation residents; and,

WHEREAS the Federal Highway Act of 1973 (P.L. 93-87) provides for U.S. Department of Transportation funding to assist Indian Tribes in financing highway traffic safety projects; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the authority to promulgate and enforce ordinances governing the conduct of all persons within the jurisdiction of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation and providing for the maintenance of law and order and administration of justice; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is desirous of contracting for funds now available for Highway Safety.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the development and submission of a proposal on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or the Tribal Administrative Director to sign the contract; to be the Tribe's representative in all future matters requiring Tribal authorization on this particular project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorities shall be for the duration of this project.



CERTIFICATION


