RESOLUTION NO. 90-50 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the Authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of its members; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a participant in the Northwest Intertribal Court System (NICS); and


WHEREAS, the Governing Board of NICS, which is comprised of delegates of the member tribes of NICS selected Doug Luna to fill the position of Associate Judge, and NICS has hired Doug Luna to fill to position and in that capacity, provide judicial services to the member tribes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council concurs with the decision to hire Doug Luna as the Associate Judge and hereby authorizes her to hear and decide Squaxin Island Tribal Court cases in accordance with the Squaxin Island Codes of Law.
