RESOLUTION NO.91-01

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the responsibility to protect the tribal fishing resource; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has developed a Squaxin Island Fishing and Shellfish Code; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, to best protect that resource finds it appropriate to revise Codes for the purpose of sound management.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby adopt and promulgate the attached revised Squaxin Island Fishing Code.
