RESOLUTION NO. 91- 07
OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the Authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is eligible to apply for Forest Management Deduction funds collected on the Henry Cooper Allotment #20 Timber Sale in 1987.

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe developed a Use Plan and budget which call for expenditures in Forest Development for reforestation, Forest Management for updating the Squaxin Island Forest Management Plan and for Shellfish Rehabilitation.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby submit the Forest Management Budget and Use Plan for Forest Management Deduction Funds effective February 1, 1991 thru September 30, 1991.
