WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is committed to a resurgence of the traditional ways, the honoring of families, and the nurturing of the children

WHEREAS; Meyer Memorial Trust has indicated their interest in providing financial support to projects which emphasize early prevention efforts to support families


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the development and submission of a proposal on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and


