



WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Island Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council recognizes the need for planning and protection of the Tribe's natural resources, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has requested funds from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for hiring a biologist trained in shellfish management and has been notified that funds are available for this purpose,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the submission of a grant application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to be effective May 1, 1991 and ending April 30, 1992 unless extended by modification.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or the Tribal Coordinating Manager to act as the official Tribal representative for this grant, with full authority to negotiate and execute all grant documents, and amendments thereto and this authority shall be for the duration of the grant.
