

## SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 91-55  
OF THE  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SOUTH PUGET INTERTRIBAL PLANNING AGENCY TO SUBMIT AND ADMINISTER A CHILD CARE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES ON BEHALF OF THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE.

Whereas, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the Authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

Whereas, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation citizens; and

Whereas, the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) on July 24, 1991 submitted a letter of intent to the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, for the operation of a Child Care Development Block Grant on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

Whereas, the Administration for Children and Families has accepted his letter of intent, and has asked for an authorizing resolution from the Tribe; and


Whereas, SPIPA will over the next 60 days consult with the Squaxin Island Tribe in completing a plan for implementation of the Child Care Development Block Grant, with the completed plan to be submitted to the Administration for Youth and Families by January 1992.


Now Let It Therefore be Resolved that the Tribal Council of the Squaxin Island Tribe does hereby authorize the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency to submit and administer, with the Administration for Children and Families, a Child Care Development Block Grant plan and proposal on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe, for the time period September 7, 1991-September 6, 1993.
