RESOLUTION NO. 91 - *64*
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Island Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has requested to borrow \$90,000 from Puget Sound Bank, Shelton Branch for the purpose of purchasing three (3) manufactured buildings for office space; and

WHEREAS, the buildings will be located on Squaxin Island Reservation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council requests that the buildings be held for collateral by Puget Sound Bank; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby grant access to the collateral on Squaxin Island Reservation should violation of the loan agreement occur.
