## RESOLUTION NO. 91-62 OF THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and


**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council wishes to continue membership in the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) pursuant to Article II, Section I(b) of the Constitution and By-laws of the National Congress of American Indians.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby authorizes necessary action to place the Tribe in membership of NCAI and authorizes pursuant to Article III, Section 1(b) \$50 to be paid for such membership.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council designates Lorna Gouin, Council Woman as delegate and voting representative to the 48th National Convention, San Francisco California.
