RESOLUTION NO. 91-63 OF THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Reservation by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health and economic well-being of the Squaxin Island Tribe and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) an intertribal consortium; and

WHEREAS. the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) has provided effective planning, technical assistance and direct human services delivered to our tribal service population since 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council in coordination with SPIPA is forwarding their formal intention to the Indian Health Service to contract for PL 93-638 takeover funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council authorizes South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency to contract for contract Health Services for the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Executive Director of South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency to prepare, submit, negotiate, execute, and administer, with the Indian Health Service, Budget proposals and any amendments thereto, for the Squaxin Island Contract Health Services Program.
