RESOLUTION NO. 92- 33
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation residents; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is committed to the professional development of all Tribal members and to providing opportunities for employment which are meaningful and contribute to the general welfare of the Tribe

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a legal member of a Tribal Consortium called South Puget Inter-Tribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) and has a number of its Federal and State grant funded program dollars passed through and administered by SPIPA; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of authorizing SPIPA to apply for the Indian Vocational Education Program which is funded by the Department of Education


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the development and the submission of a proposal on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe by SPIPA for Indian Vocational Education funds to provide on-site vocational classes for the purpose of training Tribal members to become employed in Tribally owned businesses or to start their own small businesses

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED. that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or the Tribal Administrative Director to be the Tribe's representative in all future matters requiring Tribal authorization on this particular project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorities shall be for the duration of this project.


CERTIFICATION
