

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 92-38
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation and its residents; and,

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families through the Head Start Bureau has announced the availability of financial assistance to expand Head Start enrollment; and,

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribe appears to be eligible for such a program and would realize tremendous benefits from such a program; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of applying for such a program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the development and submission of a Head Start expansion program on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or the Tribal Coordinating Director to be the Tribe's representative in all future matters requiring Tribal authorization on this particular project; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorities shall be for the duration of this project.


CERTIFICATION


