**RESOLUTION NO. 92-40
OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is responsible for managing the tribal fishery; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe's fishing rights have been affirmed under the U.S. v. Washington; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the Northwest Indian Fisheries Commission, having approved of the Constitution on October 5, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has reviewed the revisions to the Northwest Indian Fisheries Commission Constitution, Draft No. 92-02, dated July 20, 1992, and finds them to be acceptable:



CERTIFICATION


