

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE



RESOLUTION NO. 92-42 A of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation residents; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a legal member of a Tribal Consortium whose planning agency, South Puget Inter-Tribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) manages a number of Federal and State grants for the five Tribes on a pass through basis; and,

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been advised of the availability of FY 1993 funding through the Family Support Administration, Office of Community Services, for continuations of the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) through FY 1993; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of authorizing SPIPA to apply for the LIHEAP program through the Office of Community Services on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the development and the submission of a proposal on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe by SPIPA for the 1993 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency to negotiate, execute, administer a grant proposal and agreement, and any amendments thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorities shall be for the duration of this project.

CERTIFICATION

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was adopted at the regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on this 10th day of Sept, 1992, at which time a quorum was present and was passed by a vote of 4 for and 0 against with 0 abstentions.
