EMERGENCY SHELLFISH REGULATION NO. 93-13
WET STORAGE

DATE ADOPTED: JANUARY 28, 1993

AREA: SQUAXIN ISLAND
BEACH NUMBERS: S-1, S-2, S-15 THROUGH S-22

BEACH BOUNDARIES: SEE MAPS AND DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF BEACH BOUNDARIES AT THE SQUAXIN ISLAND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

WET STORAGE: LICENSED TRIBAL DIGGERS AND TRIBAL MEMBERS WITH TRIBAL OR STATE SHELLSTOCK SHIPPERS CERTIFICATION MAY USE THE ABOVE MENTIONED BEACHES FOR WET STORAGE OF ALL SHELLFISH UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS. ALL OTHER WET STORAGE PRACTICES MUST BE PERMITTED BY THE SQUAXIN ISLAND DEPT. OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

CONDITIONS:

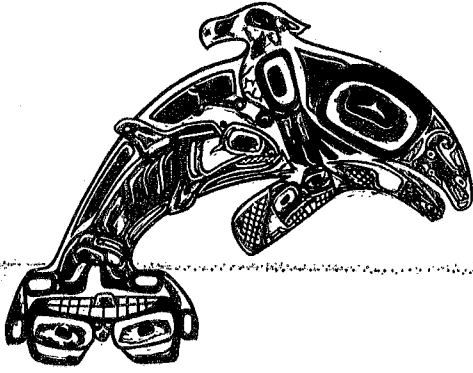
1. SHELLFISH SHALL BE STORED IN CONTAINERS MADE OF CLEAN AND SAFE MATERIALS THAT ALLOW FOR ADEQUATE WATER FLOW.
2. SHELLFISH SHALL BE STORED ON BOTTOM OR ELEVATED NO MORE THAN 12 INCHES OFF BOTTOM.
3. SHELLFISH SHALL BE STORED BETWEEN THE (-1) AND (-4) FT. TIDE LEVEL.
4. ALL CONTAINERS OF SHELLFISH SHALL BE PROPERLY TAGGED WITH TRIBALLY APPROVED SHELLFISH TAGS.
5. INDIVIDUAL LOTS (A COLLECTION OF BULK SHELLSTOCK OR CONTAINERS OF SHELLSTOCK OF NO MORE THAN ONE DAY'S HARVEST FROM A SINGLE DEFINED GROWING AREA HARVESTED BY ONE OR MORE HARVESTERS) OF SHELLFISH SHALL BE KEPT SEPARATE.
6. ALL SHELLFISH STORED ON SQUAXIN ISLAND MUST BE OBTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TRIBAL AND WASHINGTON STATE DEPT. OF HEALTH AND FISHERIES SHELLSTOCK TRANSPLANT REGULATIONS.
7. ACCURATE RECORDS MUST BE KEPT INCLUDING DATE OF INITIAL HARVEST, QUANTITY STORED, AND DATE OF REHARVEST AND BE MADE AVAILABLE UPON REQUEST FROM THE SQUAXIN DEPT. OF NATURAL RESOURCES.
8. THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE DOES NOT TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR SECURITY, POSSIBLE THEFT, MORTALITY OR ANY OTHER DESTRUCTION OR LOSS OF SHELLSTOCK WHILE IN WET STORAGE.

REGULATION: SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL SHELLFISH ORDINANCE

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL SHELLFISH ORDINANCE THE REGULATION IS HEREBY APPROVED.

SHELLFISH WET STORAGE PERMIT

PERMIT NUMBER: _____.

_____ has the permission of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council to use the beaches of Squaxin Island for wet storage of shellfish under the following conditions;

1. Area.

The permittee may use the following area(s) for wet storage of shellfish; _____.

2. Water Depth.

The permittee may wet store shellfish on the above approved area(s) at the following tidal range (based on MLLW); _____.

3. Techniques and Materials.

The permittee may wet store shellfish on the above mentioned area(s) using the following techniques and materials; _____.

4. Shellfish Source.

All shellfish stored on Squaxin Island must be from approved areas or be specially permitted to allow for a relay. If relay or transplant permit is needed, write permit # here; _____.

5. Effective Dates.

This permit shall be valid only from _____ through _____.

6. Other.

All conditions mentioned in Emergency Shellfish Regulation No. 93-13 must be met unless specifically amended in this permit.

7. Revocation.

This permit may be revoked for any reason at any time by the Tribal Council or the Squaxin Island Dept. of Natural Resources.

By issuance of this permit, it shall be deemed you have consented to the exercise of jurisdiction by the Squaxin Island Tribal Court over said person or entity in legal actions arising pursuant to the Tribal Law and Order Ordinances.

The Squaxin Island Tribe does not take responsibility for loss or damage to shellstock placed in wet storage, in accordance with this permit or with Emergency Regulation 93-08, due to theft, predation, or any other act of God, Nature or Man.

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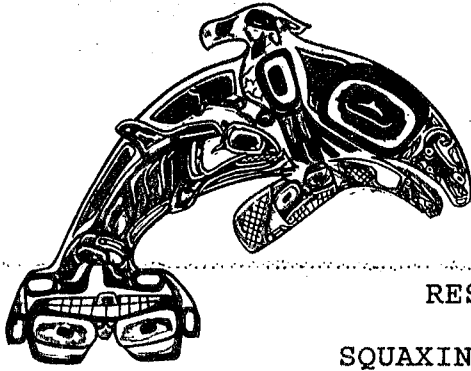

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribes been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribes recognizes the need for planning and protection of the Tribal resources, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribes has established Shellfish License fee of One Hundred (\$100.00) for each month period (4/1 - 9/30 and 10/1 - 3/31)

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the allocation that licensing towards Shellfish Enforcement.

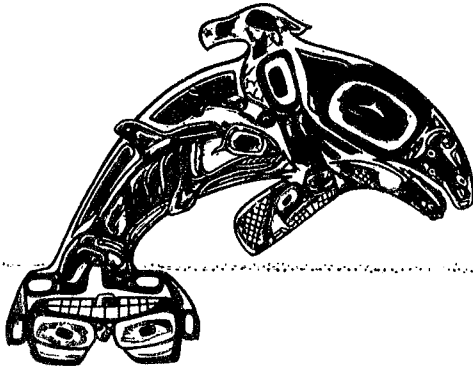

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has no adequate long-range Information Systems plan; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe desires an efficient and cost-effective Information Systems plan; and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has funds available to enable Indian Tribes to improve their capabilities to plan.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve the submission of an application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to ensure long-range Information Systems planning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or the Tribal Coordinating Director to sign and administer the Contract.


