SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council recognizes the need for planning and protection of the Tribe's natural resources, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has established a Shellfish License fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each 6 month period (4/1 - 9/30 and 10/1 - 3/31)


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the allocation of 50% of that licensing fee towards Shellfish Enforcement.
