

## SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 93-16

OF THE

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe is rich in history, culture, tradition and heritage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has recognized that protection, preservation of history, culture, tradition and heritage are necessary to ensure the survival of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe has a need to locate and designate culturally significant sites; and

**WHEREAS**, The National Parks Service has funds available to enable Indian Tribes to identify, document and evaluate important historic places and objects.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve the submission of an application to the National Park Service to locate and designate culturally significant sites.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or the Tribal Coordinating Director to sign and administer the Contract.


**CERTIFICATION**


