RESOLUTION NO. 93-22
OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is rich in history, culture, tradition and heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has recognized that Sovereignty and Self Governance are vital to the future of our Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs is conducting a Self Governance Demonstration Project; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a BIA sanctioned Self Governance Planning Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman to enter into Self Governance Compact and Annual Funding Agreement negotiations for FY 1994 with the United States Department of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Self Governance Coordinator to represent the Tribe and conduct the negotiations.


