RESOLUTION NO. 93-39
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the constitution and by-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the authority to promulgate laws and ordinances for the protection and well-being of the Tribe and it's members, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council finds it necessary and appropriate to authorize by resolution the following guidelines for entry onto Squaxin Island. Those allowed without a permit include; all Squaxin Island Tribal Members; all dependent children of Squaxin Island Tribal Members that are under the age of eighteen (18) and accompanied by their Squaxin Island Tribal Member Parent; all Squaxin Island Tribal Spouses that possess a Spousal Card and that are accompanied by their Squaxin Island Tribal Member Spouse. All others must first obtain a Permit to Enter Squaxin Island from the Natural Resources Department.


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council finds it necessary and appropriate to authorize by resolution that all Squaxin Island Tribal Members must first obtain a subsistence permit before shellfishing on Squaxin Island.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby enacts this resolution effective the 3rd day of June, 1993.


