RESOLUTION NO. 93-46

OF THE

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the Portland Area Indian Health Board whose primary purpose is to make known the health needs of the Portland Area member Tribes - to impact the decision making process of the Indian Health Service and the United States Congress in determining funding packages and establishing priorities for delivery of services to the Indian Tribes.


WHEREAS, the Portland Area Indian Health Board has requested that each Tribe appoint a delegate and alternate to represent them at Health Board meetings and inform the Tribal Council of important issues pertaining to Health Services.
