RESOLUTION NO. 93 - 48
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Community; and,

WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, under Project PO 93-686A will provide "Sanitation Facilities for Existing Homes..." for the Squaxin Island Tribal Community;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the Project Document PO-93-686A to provide sanitation facilities for Tribal members and authorizes the Tribal Chairman to enter into an agreement for the Project PO 93-686A on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe.
