OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and


WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is responsible for managing the tribal fishery.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve and adopt the following Subsistence/Ceremonial Shellfish Harvest Policy:


1. Tribal subsistence harvest will be allowed only on Squaxin Island. The Squaxin Island Department of Natural Resources (DNR) will permit this activity. Only one permit will be issued per harvester per seven (7) day period. The harvester may dig only on beaches permitted by the DNR.
2. Ceremonial Harvest (for funerals, pow-wows, first salmon ceremonies, etc.) will be allowed off-reservation and on Squaxin Island. All aspects, including but not limited to, eligibility, harvest location and time periods of Ceremonial harvest will be regulated by the DNR. All persons participating in a Ceremonial Harvest must be permitted by the DNR and be in possession of a copy of said permit.
3. All Tribal members may harvest recreational limits (as defined by the State of Washington) of shellfish on beaches and under the terms as outlined by the State of Washington.

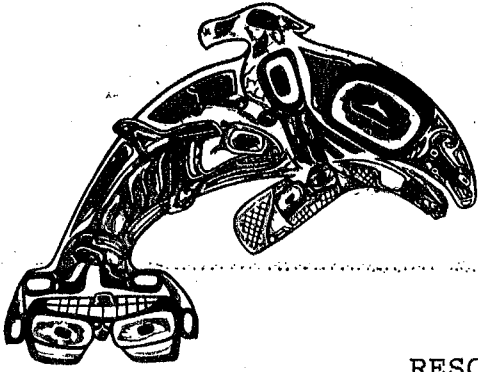




