



# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 93- 73  
OF THE  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the Authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well being of its members; and

WHEREAS, alcohol and substance abuse is reconized as a serious problem for some tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986 authorizes Indian Tribes to develop Tribal Action. Plans and provides funding for the implementation of these plans.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the Tribal Action Plan, which meets federal standards, to address alcohol and substance abuse problems in the tribal community; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health and Social Services Director is assigned the responsibility of coordinating the reforming of a Tribal Coordinating Committee, and acting as technical advisor to the identified committee's and liason between the Council and the Committee's. The two committee's identified as the TCC is the Elder's Committee and the Youth Committee.
