RESOLUTION NO. 93-75
OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is rich in history, culture, tradition and heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has recognized that Sovereignty and Self-Governance are vital to the future of our Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has announced the availability of Community Development Block Grants; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has a need to construct a multi-purpose health facility at a cost of \$360,00.00, which includes a \$90,000.00 Tribal match.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize and approve the appropriation of Tribal matching funds in the amount of \$43,000.00 to cover the cost of moveable equipment, project manager, contingencies, and admin./audit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the use of Tribal land, valued at \$47,000.00, at the entrance of the reservation, for the site of the Squaxin Island Health Center.
