RESOLUTION NO. 93 - 82
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Community; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council desires to obtain satisfactory water supply and adequate waste disposal facilities for Indians of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has requested assistance of IHS under Public Law 86-121 in the construction of sanitation facilities for Indians on the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation; and,


WHEREAS, Indian Health Service desires to assist in the provision of sanitation facilities for Indians on the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby agree to Memorandum of Agreement between the Indian Health Service and the Squaxin Island Tribe, Public Law 86-121, Project 92-804A.
