RESOLUTION NO. 94-107
OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is rich in history, culture, tradition and heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has recognized that Sovereignty and Self-Governance are vital to the future of our Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has signed a Self Governance Compact and Annual Funding Agreement with the Indian Health Service.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Indian Health Service to change the Contract Health Service Delivery Area (CHSDA) designation from Mason County only to include the counties of Thurston, Pierce, Kitsap and Grays Harbor, as agreed to in the Self Governance negotiations, and to take effect beginning Fiscal Year 1995, October 1, 1994.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Executive Director to represent the Tribe and to sign any appropriate documents with the IHS.
