RESOLUTION NO. 94 - 110

OF THE

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a draft budget which shall be presented to the Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the departmental budgets have been compiled and presented to the Budget Committee which has reviewed the information and does recommend approval by the Tribal Council; and


WHEREAS, the draft budget does not obligate more funds than are expected to become available; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Council does hereby approve the draft budget as presented by the Budget Committee; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this information is to be presented for review, at a public hearing prior to final adoption.
