
RESOLUTION OF THE

RESOLUTION# 94-128

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is an Indian Tribe organized under the Indian Reorganization Act; and the Squaxin Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe by the authority of Article II of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe approved by the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965, and,
