RESOLUTION NO. 94 - 133

OF THE

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Kamilche Trading Post has made a significant profit in the past year and wishes to share that profit with the Squaxin Community and;

WHEREAS, KTP and Enterprises Division of the Tribe has requested permission from the Tribal Council to distribute a one time per capita payment of \$75.00 to all enrolled Tribal Members, based on the profits of Kamilche Trading Post for 1994; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is in full support of this request and hereby approves this per capita payment to all Members of the Tribe which will be administered by Enterprises.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a trust will be established for members under eighteen years of age and their portion will be distributed to them upon their eighteenth birthday.
