WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members; and


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, exercising their responsibility in Article 3.01.040, Authority of the Tribal Council, of the Squaxin Island Fishing Code, hereby issues the following Shellfish Resolution.

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby recognizes the Shellfish Monitor to have the following authority and civil obligations as a Squaxin Island employee;

- 1) The authority to refuse shellfish bag tags to any Tribal shellfish harvester who refuses to provide to the shellfish monitor, a current and valid Treaty Indian Identification Card issued by the Squaxin Island Resources Department.
- 2) The obligation as a Squaxin Island Tribal employee to report by radio or other means, any illegal shellfish activities to Law Enforcement personnel.
