RESOLUTION NO. 94-48  
OF THE  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens: and

**WHEREAS**, SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION (SAMSHA) has announced its request for proposals for this years funding, for the purpose of providing comprehensive community mental health services for children and adolescents with serious emotional disturbances: and

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board (NPAIHB) is willing to prepare a proposal and administer it, if funded, on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe.

**NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribe authorizes the NPAIHB to submit and administer, if funded, on behalf of the Tribe a proposal to SAMSHA.

## CERTIFICATION
