RESOLUTION NO. 94-81 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted by it members to acquire, manage, lease, or use tribal real property and other tribal assets, together with all improvements which may be acquired by the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the general goal of making the Squaxin Island Reservation and economic, social, cultural and political land base for the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council on be half of the Tribe has purchased 2 parcels of property within the Reservation which will be developed as part of the Social Services complex on the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has determined that tribal real property can best be managed and protected if it is owned by the United States in trust for the Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby request that the United States, pursuant to 25 CFR 151 and under the authority of the Indian Reorganization Act 48 Stat. 984, accept title to the following described real property in trust for the Squaxin Island Tribe.
