WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the budget committee appointed by the Tribal Council has been charged with reviewing all revisions to the budget approved by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee has reviewed Budget Revisions numbered 94-06 through 94-08 as described in the attached memorandum, and has recommended their passage; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve the amendments to the approved budget as recommended by the Budget Committee.

Subject: Budget Modifications

The Budget Committee met on June 30, 1994. Committee members present included: David Burnett, Alene Whitener, Carrie Smith and Deborah Stoehr. The Committee unanimously recommended the approval of the following budget/budget modifications:

94-06 Administration, BIA S.G. Start-up, FY94.

This is additional funding for the Tribe. In order to fully implement the Budget Ordinance and provide consistent budgeting processes the Tribe must acquire adequate computer equipment, software and training.

94-07 Natural Resources, SPI Totten, FY94 Mod #2, 06-15-94.

Primary purpose of modification is to add line item for Contractual Services which was inadvertently omitted in previous budget.

94-08 Natural Resources, Shellfish Management, FY94 Mod #3, 06-30-94.

Primary purpose of modification is to increase Capitalized Equipment to cover costs of building a barge for hauling gravel.

The Committee also discussed Tribal Council, Fish Tax-Council and Indirect Cost Expenditures/Budgets. There is some concern regarding over expenditure of budgets if current spending rates continue. The Indirect Cost Proposal for FY95 was distributed for informational purposes. The Committee discussed the results of FY95 Community Needs Survey and possible methodologies for prioritizing. The Committee was given an IHS S.G. Compact update.
