



# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 94-92  
of the  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal reservation residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal recognizes that the health of it's Tribal Members is of utmost importance, and that good health enhances the social, economic, and physical well-being of the tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council gives full support to submit an application for the Back Support and Education program, to provide services to tribal members for a one year project period;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve submission of the Back Support and Injury Prevention program application for a one year project period to provide services to the Indian families within the Squaxin community; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Executive Director to be the Tribe's representative in all future matters requiring Tribal authorization on this particular project; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this authority shall be for the duration of this project.
