RESOLUTION NO. 95- 06
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to obtain satisfactory water supply and adequate waste disposal facilities for the Community of Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has provided improvement to the community water system by installing a new water storage tank and associated controls, piping and fencing under Project PO-91-574; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service, in accordance with the terms of the Memorandum of Agreement and Project Summary, and their Amendments, pursuant to Section 7(a) (4) of Public Law 86-121 is transferring to the Squaxin Island Tribe all community water facilities and appurtenances constructed under this project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the transfer of facilities constructed under IHS Project PO-91-574.
