



# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 95- 109  
OF THE  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing for the needs of education and economic development of the Tribal Citizens, and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the Puget Sound Intertribal Planning Agency(SPIPA); and

**WHEREAS**, SPIPA is presently developing a project to assist Indian Tribes to coordinate and develop new and innovative approaches to tribal economic self-sufficiency and cultural preservation.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the SPIPA Board Chairman to submit to the Northwest Area Foundation a grant proposal for funding for a joint SPIPA/Evergreen State College Native Economic Development Arts Initiative.
