

# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 95- 11  
of the  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to obtain satisfactory water supply and adequate waste disposal (sanitation) facilities for members of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe has requested assistance of IHS under Public Law 86-121 in the construction of sanitation facilities for members of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe; and,


WHEREAS, some homes are qualified for sanitation facilities or are expected to qualify this year; and,

WHEREAS, Indian Health Service desires to assist in the provision of sanitation facilities for members of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves entering into the Memorandum of Agreement Project PO-95-873A between The Indian Health Service and the Squaxin Island Tribe for the purpose of providing sanitation facilities to Squaxin Island tribal members.
