WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with conducting the business of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has determined a need to establish an Eviction Policy, to allow for the legal removal of tenant(s) and\or property and those court actions which precede the removal, as it relates to Tribally owned properties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby approves and establishes this Eviction Policy dated March 2, 1995.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR UPDATE

David Burnett presented a draft policy that Lt. Johnny has developed in order to take certain actions on the removal of tenants from Tribal property.

Lt. Johnny reported that he has revised the Mason County format regarding eviction procedures. Tom Sheldon, who was in attendance, stated that this is becoming a real problem for Tribes.

The Council, after some discussion, agreed that this is a policy we need to have. Sue McFarlane made a motion to approve the policy and accompanying Resolution 95-18 and Arnold Cooper seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

David Burnett presented a draft Policy and Procedures Manual developed for the Treatment Center. The Council will review this manual and vote on this at the next Council meeting.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Nancy Dufraine, Social Services Director presented the second draft of the CPT members recommended for approval by Council.

Two of those listed have asked to be dropped from the list and after some discussion, the Council by consensus, added Chairman Dave Lopeman and Executive Director, David Burnett to the Team.

The Team membership is Shelley Rawding, Brenda Dorsey, Lorna Gouin, Sue McFarlane, Mark Snyder, Rose Algea, Russel Cooper, Dave Lopeman and David Burnett.

Arnold Cooper made a motion to formally approve this CPT team and Sue seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

The next item of business was the discussion of an ICW case. There were no minutes recorded on the case.

The court does however, require that the Council hear the issues and provide for the court, a motion for Non-Objection therefore the following was noted for the benefit of the Court:
