



## SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 95-43  
OF THE  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe is rich in history, culture, tradition and heritage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA); and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe presently operates through SPIPA a Child Care Development Block Grant Program designed to provide needed child care to eligible families within the Squaxin Island Community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe is advised of the availability of continued funding for FY96 through the Department of Health and Human Services for the Child Care and Development Block Grant Program.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency to prepare, submit, negotiate, execute, and administer, with the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, a grant application and updated Plan, and any amendments thereto, for a FY96 Child Care Development Block Grant Program on behalf of the Squaxin Island Community.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that SPIPA hereby directed to utilize the attached population data for computing the Squaxin Island Tribe's funding allocation for the FY96 Child Care Development Block Grants Program.
