

# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 96 - 73

OF THE

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; **and**

**WHEREAS**, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members; **and**

**WHEREAS**, the 1997 Fiscal Year budget has been prepared in accordance with the Budget Ordinance, which included input and review by the Tribal community; **and**

**WHEREAS**, the final budget has been reviewed by the Budget Committee and does not obligate more funds than are expected to become available; **and**


**WHEREAS**, the budget has been prepared including a general increase in the federal salary schedule.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve the final budget for Fiscal Year 1997 in the following amounts.


C E R T I F I C A T I O N


