RESOLUTION NO. 96 - 75

OF THE

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; **and**

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of Tribal Members; **and**

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Tribe has been a member of the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) since its inception in 1976; **and**


WHEREAS, the Tribe presently operates a Family Violence Prevention and Services program designed to address family violence issues within the community; **and**

WHEREAS, the Tribe is advised of the availability of continued funding for FY-97 through the Department of Health and Human Services for the Family Violence Prevention and Services program.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** does hereby authorize SPIPA to prepare, submit, negotiate, execute, and administer, with the Department of Health and Human Services, a grant proposal and agreement and any amendments thereto, for an FY-97 Family Viience Prevention and Services Program on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribal Community.
