RESOLUTION NO. 97-24

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe is rich in history, culture, tradition and heritage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe has recognized the importance of community empowerment and the important role women have played in community healing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council recognizes the importance of health programs for improving and enhancing the health services of Native American women.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize and support the submission of the Squaxin Island grant proposal for the Indian Women's Health Demonstration Program of the Department of Health and Human Services and the Indian Health Service.

### CERTIFICATION


