RESOLUTION NO. 97-64
OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic well-being of the Tribe and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has been a member of the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA) since its inception in 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe presently operates a Family Violence Prevention and Services Program designed to address family violence within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is advised of the availability of continued funding for FY1998 through the Department of Health and Human Services for the Family Violence Prevention and Services Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize SPIPA to prepare, negotiate, execute, and administer, with the Department of Health and Human Services, a grant proposal and agreement and any amendments thereto, for a FY1998 Family Violence Prevention and Services Program on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribal Community.

CERTIFICATION


