RESOLUTION NO. 98-16
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** is charged with the duty of protecting, the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation residents; and,

WHEREAS, the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** has made it a priority to ensure the survival of the culture and language of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the **Administration for Native Americans** has announced the availability of funds for Native American Language projects that promote the survival and continuing vitality of Native American languages,


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** does hereby authorize submission of an application to ANA on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe for funds to conduct an assessment of the language and establish long-range goals to ensure the survival of the language for the Tribal Community.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or the Executive Director to be the Tribe's signatory and representative in all future matters requiring Tribal authorization on this particular project; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that these authorities shall be for the duration of this project.

CERTIFICATION

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was adopted at the regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on this 12th day of March 1998, at which time a quorum was present and was passed by a vote of 3 for and 0 against with 0 abstentions.
